Nara City has compiled the initial budget for FY 2024 as a “budget to strengthen future growth potential”. Learning from the lessons of Noto Peninsula Earthquake, we will focus on projects aimed at improving disaster prevention capabilities and making towns more resilient. In addition, while leveraging past investments in the town, we aim to be a “city where people can live happily both now and in the future”.

Protect yourself from "Internal Bleeding Caused by Infectious Colon Diseases" (Such as O-157)!

The Nature of Infectious Colon Diseases that Causes Internal Bleeding & Main Infection Routes

You might get infected by eating raw or insufficiently heated meat such as liver, etc. Infection can spread from person to person via toilets, shared towels, etc. Their incubation period is 3-8 days. In the human body, infection produces strong "verotoxins" which cause serious kidney and brain damage.

Prevention

- Meat should be cooked thoroughly (Germs die when heated to a central temperature of 75 degrees Celsius for one minute.) Use a separate pair of chopsticks for handling raw meat; do not use them for eating.
- Make sure to wash your hands thoroughly after using the bathroom, and before and after cooking. Wash cooking equipment and kitchen utensils diligently and sterilize them. Try to eat as soon as possible after cooking.

Rubella Antibody Examination

Maternal infection with rubella virus during early pregnancy may cause Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) in the baby.

Application Period: From May 1 (Wed.) to Jan. 31, 2025 (Fri.)

Eligibility: Those who will be registered as Nara City citizens on the examination day; and who are women planning a pregnancy or family members living with a woman whose antibody titer is 16 times and under according to an HI test (hemagglutination inhibition test) or under 8.0 according to EIA (enzyme immunoassay).

* Excluding those who have already had a rubella examination, have been vaccinated against rubella twice, have suffered from rubella, or are currently pregnant.

Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for Those Born in May 2021)

Those Eligible: Between age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday.

Method: The first vaccination are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second shot.

Things to bring: Preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook* and Insurance Card or other ID.

* Those who are not registered as residents of Nara City are not eligible.

* Those who are breastfeeding need to notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

Those born between April 2, 2004 and April 1, 2007 are eligible to get the JEV for free until the day before the 20th birthday, thanks to preferential measures.

***2) Human Papilloma Virus Infection (HPV):**

Girls who missed a chance for this vaccination due to Nara City not offering the vaccine and were born from April 2, 1997 to April 1, 2008 are eligible for catch-up vaccinations until March 31, 2025.
