
芳德寺柳生家墓所附列堂和尚墓所

Graveyard of the Yagyu Clan

The Yagyu clan was a samurai family active in the 16th to 19th centuries, well known for swordsmanship. In 1636, it became a daimyo (feudal lord) family serving the Tokugawa shogunate. When Hotokuji Temple was built in 1638, the clan's cemetery was relocated here. There are 86 graves. In the center lies the grave of Yagyu Munenori, the clan's first daimyo.

主な人物 Key figures

柳生宗厳	筒井氏、三好氏、松永氏などに仕えた。上泉信綱から新陰流を 継承。1594年家康に秘術を披露し、宗矩を家康に仕えさせた。
Yagyu Munetoshi (Sekishusai)	The father of Yagyu Munenori, the clan's first daimyo. Shinkage-ryu school of swordsmanship was passed on to him by its founder, Kamiizumi Nobutsuna.
柳生宗矩 (但馬守) Yagyu Munenori (Tajimanokami)	石舟斎の五男。家康に仕え、秀忠·家光の兵法指南役を務め、 家光の下で大名となる(初代藩主)。1638年芳徳寺を創建。
	Munetoshi's fifth son. In 1594 he began serving under Tokugawa Ieyasu, who would later become the first Tokugawa shogun. He served as sword instructor to the second and third shoguns. In 1636 he became the clan's first daimyo.
柳生三厳(十兵衛)	宗矩の長男。新陰流の研究に努めた。家督を継いだが、四年後に 急死した。
Yagyu Mitsuyoshi (Jubei)	Munenori's oldest son. He studied the Shinkage-ryu school, and took over as clan head when his father passed, but died suddenly only four years later.
列堂義仙 Retsudo Gisen	宗矩の四男。芳徳寺第一世住職。 Munenori's fourth son. First abbot of Hotokuji Temple.
上泉信綱	上野国(群馬県)の武将。新陰流の祖。
(伊勢守)	A samurai from the Kanto region in eastern Japan, who founded the

柳生久三郎 Yagyu Kyuzaburo	浅野家に仕えて朝鮮の役に従軍、蔚山で戦死。 He fought under the Japanese ruler Toyotomi Hideyoshi in the Japanese invasion of Korea. He died in Korea in 1597.
柳生主馬	朝鮮出身で柳生家に仕え、柳生姓を賜ったという。
Yagyu Shume	It is said that Shume was born in Korea but was adopted into the Yagyu clan and confered the surname Yagyu.
柳生俊睦	八代藩主の三男。酒を好んだと伝え、墓は台石が酒樽、塔身が徳利、
(乏斎)	屋根が杯となっている。
Yagyu Toshichika	The third son of the eighth Yagyu clan daimyo. He is said to have loved drinking.
(Bosai)	His tombstone is shaped like a sake bottle on a sake cask, with a sake cup on top.
