Every adult might suffer from dementia, through illness or injury. When brain cells are damaged or their function deteriorates, memory, use of words and analysis of information, etc. deteriorate, and that leads to the "state" in which some difficulties appear in one's life.

What Is World Alzheimer's Day?

On September 21, 1994, the 10th annual conference of Alzheimer's Disease International was held in Scotland. On the first day of the conference, the federation, in collaboration with the World Health Organization (WHO), declared that the day would be designated as "World Alzheimer's Day."

On-Line Infection Survey by the City Healthcare Center started.

While the Nara City Healthcare Center has carried out epidemiological surveys of all infected persons by telephone, an on-line survey was also started at the end of July. An SMS (short text message) is sent to the mobile phone number specified on the outbreak report. Please send a report about your health condition by yourself to that URL.

* To those who do not have a mobile phone, have severer than moderate disease, or have a risk of developing severe symptoms because of being 65 years old and over or having an underlying condition, communication by telephone will also be used the same as before.

1. After a doctor diagnoses the illness, a report of outbreak is submitted to the healthcare center.

as of Aug. 12, 2022

Those Eligible: Five months or more have passed since your third dose and the following apply: 1) **Sixty years of age and older**, 2) **Those who have an underlying disease, or who have risk of potential severe conditions diagnosed by their doctor**, 3) **Health-care workers or nursing home and long-term care facility workers (Items 2 and 3 are applicable to only those who are between ages 18 - 60)**

Tuberculosis Prevention Week Sept. 24 (Sat.) - 30 (Fri.)

Tuberculosis is not an illness in the past.

Tuberculosis is still one of the major infectious diseases in Japan. In Nara City, 36 new tuberculosis patients were diagnosed last year. Learn about tuberculosis and its prevention to protect yourself and those close to you.

Three things to note to prevent tuberculosis.

1. If you have cold-like symptoms for more than two weeks, see a doctor.
2. Have you had your annual X-ray examination of the chest?
3. Try to live a healthy lifestyle.

Stomach Cancer Examination: X-Ray (involving drinking barium on that day)

Lung Cancer Examination: Chest X-Ray (including tuberculosis test)

Fee: 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only)600 yen as an additional fee for sputum test based on a general check-up for lung cancer (postage might need to be paid).

Those Eligible: 40 years old and over. Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in the previous or this fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible) and who had a lung cancer low-dose CT examination in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible) are excluded.

Others: For those who are breast feeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.
