

We continue to provide the primary (1st and 2nd) vaccinations for the existing virus. Shots for babies & toddlers (from 6 months to 4 years old) and children are being conducted.

* Be careful to keep a sufficient interval between vaccinations.

To Evacuate Yourself Safely

Evacuation shelters in Nara City are designated.

Public elementary schools and junior high schools, Kominkan, and Human Rights and Cultural Centers, etc., in Nara City are designated as evacuation shelters when a disaster occurs. (For more information, please look at page 11 of *Shimin-dayori*, *a* Japanese version NCL)

An evacuation shelter is the place where residents can stay during a necessary time when they cannot live in their homes due to a disaster or a typhoon. Nara City Crisis Management Headquarters will decide the establishment of the shelters as needed. Please confirm nearby shelters in normal time. It will make your evacuation calmly and safely when a disaster occurs.

Garbage Collection

Bring Garbage to the Collection Site by 7:30 on the Collection Day.

Please Do Not Park Near the Collection Site.

If there is a car near the collection site, garbage may not be collected to avoid contaminating the car with litter or sewage scattered during loading. In such cases, the residents who use the collection site must be responsible for disposing of the garbage left uncollected.
