Information about cancer examinations for the AYA generation (Those of age 15-39)

Cancer rates are increasing rapidly now, once people enter the AYA generation.
The cancer rate of all generation is 2.5 %, which looks relatively low, but the leading cause of death for this generation is cancer.

The types of cancer between men and women are different.

18,000 people in the AYA generation developed cancer in 2018. 70% of them were women.
Patients in their thirties account for 70- 80 % of those in the AYA generation, by age group.

More than ever, breast cancer patients are on the rise, and cervical cancer has been seen at a younger age.

Patients with breast cancer more than doubled in 2015, compared with 1985.
The westernization of eating habits is thought to be one of the reasons.
The peak age at which cervical cancer develops has lowered, compared over the same period of 1985- 2015.

Please take the cancer examinations as the city is offering them to those age 20 and over.

Nara City is striving to increase rates of cancer examinations for the younger generation.

The city is especially worried because even within the AYA generation, people in their twenties have fewer exams.



Information on breast cancer and cervical cancer examinations

Tickets were distributed to those who were eligible for examinations in late June.
You can take these examinations once every two years.

Please notify the Health Promotion Section if you are not eligible this year, if you received the ticket last year but didn't have the examination.

Free tickets will be delivered to those who are eligible to take these examinations for the first time.

Those eligible, as of April 1: 20 year-old women for cervical cancer examinations

40 year-old women for breast cancer examinations

Get Vaccinated against HPV (human papillomavirus) to Prevent Cervical Cancer!

It is estimated that more than 50 percent of women who have sexual contact will contract HPV at least once in their lifetime. Infections can lead to cervical, anal, and vaginal cancer. In order to prevent infection, the HPV vaccination is available for women aged 12 (the 6th grade of elementary school) and 16 (the 1st grade of high school).

A Catch-up Vaccination Is on the Way.

Those Eligible: Those born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2006

Notices are being sent to those eligible individually. (Vaccinations will be available even without the notice.)

The third injection completes the vaccination. Those who have a long interval after their first or second injection are also eligible for the remaining injection(s). Vaccinations will be given at registered medical institutions in Nara City. Please make a reservation in advance. If you wish

to receive injection(s) outside of the city, please contact Kenko-Zoshin-Ka (Health Care Section).

Things to Bring: 1) *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*

- 2) Identification such as your Health Insurance Card, etc.
- 3) Documents on vaccination history for those who have already received their first and second injections

The HIV Vaccination Campaign Has Resumed.

Persistent pain and other symptoms after the vaccination have been reported. Due to difficulties in providing adequate information on side effects, the vaccination campaign was suspended until recently. Last year, however, an expert panel determined that there are no safety issues with the HIV vaccine and that the benefits of vaccination are clearly greater than the side effects. The national government has re-launched the vaccination campaign.

For Those Vaccinated at Their Own Expense

Those who reached the age for the regular HPV vaccination in the years when the campaign was discontinued and received the vaccination at their own expense will be reimbursed in autumn.

**Information about the Fourth, Booster Vaccination against COVID-19
as of July 12, 2022**

Those Eligible: Five months or more have passed since your third vaccination and the following apply:

- 1) Sixty years of age and older
- 2) From age 18 to under age 60 who have an underlying disease, or who have risk of potential severe conditions diagnosed by their doctor

But please consult with your doctor about whether you can get the vaccine or not.

Wishing for World Peace

*** Let’s ring the bell of peace.**

The peace bell on the rooftop of Nara City Hall will ring on the same date and time when the atomic bombs were dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, and Nara City also asks the temples in the city to ring their bells for peace.

Nara City will observe one minute of silence. If possible, please offer a silent prayer at home or at work.

Attention: Food Poisoning Caused by Campylobacter and Internal Bleeding Coli such as O157 Occurs Frequently

Note the Following Points:

- 1) Don't eat raw meat or undercooked meat
- 2) Heat the inside of meat completely when you grill meat or barbecue. (Use different chopsticks for cooking and eating)
- 3) After cooking meat, disinfect your cooking utensils before using them again

Three Important Rules for Preventing Food Poisoning

- 1) Don't get germs
Wash your hands often. Thoroughly wash cooking utensils
- 2) Don't let germs multiply
Cook smoothly and quickly, and don't leave food at room temperature for hours (use refrigerator storage)
- 3) Sterilization
Heat the inside of food to 75 degrees Celsius or over for more than one minute

Stomach Cancer Examination: X-Ray (involving drinking barium on that day)

Lung Cancer Examination: Chest-X Ray (including tuberculosis test)

Fee: 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only)
600 yen as an additional fee for sputum test based on a general check-up for lung cancer (postage might need to be paid).

Those Eligible: 40 years old and over. Pregnant women: those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in the previous or this fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible) and who had a lung cancer low-dose CT examination in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible) are excluded.

Others: For those who are breast feeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.
