### Please Consider Taking A Booster Vaccination (Third Time) against COVID-19.

Booster vaccinations (third time) for those who are 12 to 18 years old have now started. It is available for people of all ages “after a lapse of six months since receiving the second vaccination”. As the time when vouchers are mailed may change depending on when your second shot was, please confirm by calling the COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center or checking the Nara City website.

\* The vaccine for ages 12 to 17 is manufactured only by Pfizer.

#### Vaccination for 5 to 11 year old children begins

Vaccination vouchers have been sent to all eligible people. Children who will be turning five will be sent vouchers the month after their birthday. We would like to ask both parents and children to read carefully the leaflet which will be sent to those eligible people, and understand both positive points (such as infection prevention) as well as negative points (such as side effects) of the vaccination before deciding whether to receive it or not.

### Rubella Antibody Examination

Infection with rubella in early pregnancy might cause disabilities in the baby (congenital rubella syndrome) such as loss of hearing, cataracts, heart disease, etc.

**Those Eligible:** Those who will be registered as Nara City citizens on the examination day and expect to become pregnant, or who live together with a pregnant woman whose antibody titer is 16 times and under by HI test (hemagglutination inhibition test) or under 8.0 by EIA (enzyme immunoassay).

**Those Ineligible:** Those who have already had a rubella antibody examination, have been vaccinated against rubella twice, suffered from rubella, or are currently pregnant.

## Protect yourself from “Infectious Colon Diseases Causing Internal Bleeding” (Such as O-157)!

### Nature of Infectious Colon Diseases Causing Internal Bleeding & Main Infection Routes

- \* They are highly infectious. Even very small amounts of germs can be infectious.
- \* Their incubation period is 3-8 days; it is difficult to trace the path of infection.
- \* In the human body, they produce strong “Verotoxins” which cause serious kidney and brain damage. Particular attention should be paid to infants and the elderly.
- \* You might get infected by eating raw or insufficiently heated raw liver, etc. Infection can spread from person to person via toilets and shared towels, etc.

### Prevention

- \* Meat, including liver and other organ meats, should be cooked thoroughly. Germs die when heated to a central temperature of 75 degrees Celsius for one minute.
- \* When handling raw meat, use dedicated tongs or chopsticks, separate from individuals’ chopsticks for eating.
- \* Wash your hands thoroughly after using the bathroom, and before and after cooking, especially when you touch raw meat. Wash kitchen utensils carefully and sterilize them.
- \* Try to eat as soon as possible after cooking.

## Preliminary Examination Leaflets were Sent in Late April (to Those Born in March 2022)

## Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for Those Born in May 2019)

**Those Eligible:** Between age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday.

**Method:** The first vaccination are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second.

**Things to bring:** Preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother’s and Child’s Health Handbook* and your child’s ID document.

\*Those who are not registered as residents of Nara City are not eligible.

**Fee:** 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only)  
600 yen as an additional fee for sputum test based on a general check-up for lung cancer (postage might need to be paid).

**Those Eligible:** 40 years old and over. Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible) are excluded.

**Others:** For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

**\*Japanese Encephalitis Vaccination (JEV)**

- 1) Those born between April 2, 2002 and April 1, 2007 are eligible to get the JEV for free until the day before their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday thanks to preferential measures.
- 2) Those born between April 2, 2008 and October 1, 2009 who have not finished all three times of the 1<sup>st</sup> term can get the other shots from age 9 to before their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday.

\*Human Papilloma Virus Infection (HPV): Those who missed a chance for vaccination due to the withholding of active solicitation by Nara City and were born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2006 are eligible for catch-up vaccinations until March 31, 2025. **Prevent Passive Smoking!**

Passive smoking means inhaling smoke hanging in the air or cigarette smoke directly from smokers around you, although you yourself don't smoke.

The new smoking protocol "Kaisei-Kenko-Zoshin-Ho (Revised Health Promotion Act)" was issued to prevent passive smoking.

Smoking affects not only the health of the smoker, but also that of the people around them. Let's follow the new rules and establish a city without passive smoking.

**"Kaisei-Kenko-Zoshin-Ho (Revised Health Promotion Act)" (Excerpt)**

1. Indoor smoking is prohibited in: schools, child welfare buildings, hospitals, government offices, buses, taxis and airplanes.
2. Smoking is prohibited in facilities used by many people (over two people), ferries, pleasure cruisers, trains and other places than above (1).
3. Smoking is prohibited in stores where small-scale business are among existing restaurants (Restaurants with a seating area under 100 m<sup>2</sup> which is run by an individual or a small or medium-sized business.)
