## Public Support for Those Affected by COVID-19

### For People with Difficulties in Daily Life

#### The Nara Municipality Will Provide a Special Relief Benefit of 100,000 Yen per Household.

Nara City will extend monetary support to households in need due to the prolonged COVID-19 pandemic.

**Those Eligible:** (1) Tax-exempt households: Households with all members exempt from residential tax in FY 2021 on a per capita basis as of Dec. 10, 2021.

(2) Households suffering from sudden financial changes: Households whose finances went through drastic changes and all members can be regarded as exempt from residential tax on a per capita basis due to the pandemic.

\* Not applicable if all household members are dependent on a taxable relative. You cannot receive both (1) and (2).

#### Application Deadline and Method:

(1) Tax-exempt households: May 31 (Tues.)

Confirmation documents have been sent to eligible households. Please check and fill in the forms, and send them back with the required documents in the enclosed envelope.

(2) Households suffering from sudden financial changes: Sept. 30 (Fri.)

**An application is required.** Please send in an application form with the required documents. (They can also be submitted at the City Hall counter.)

### Support for Those Who Have Financial Difficulty with National Pension Contribution Payments

A temporary special contribution exemption system/payment postponement system, and special schemes for student payments, will be granted to those who have financial difficulty in making National Pension contribution payments due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

### For Child-rearing Families and Those Close to Childbirth

#### Parenting support for children whose parents (guardians) have been infected with coronavirus.

Children can be supported if their parents (guardians) become infected and can't find someone to take care of their children. (No cost burden)

#### Temporary Support

Children can temporarily stay and be cared for at facilities in the city.

**Those Eligible:** Children under elementary school age with an address in the city in principle.

\* There is a limit to the number of places available. Only for children with a negative PCR test.

## Support for children at home

City staff will call, visit, and check on children's daily lives.

**Those Eligible:** Children junior high school students and above with an address in the city in principle.

## Nara City **Changing the medical examination method to prevent the spread of infection.**

### Infant Checkups

#### \* 4-month-old babies' • 10-month-old babies' checkups

The normal consultation period for the visit is one month, but for the time being it is set at two months.

#### \* 19-month-old babies' • 3-1/2-year-old babies' checkups

Normally, checkups are given in groups, but temporarily, each medical institution will conduct checkups individually. (The consultation period is for two months.)

Those who were sent the medical examination slip should read it and the information carefully and attend the checkup at the appropriate time.

\* Both are conducted at designated medical facilities in Nara City.

#### Notice about COVID-19 Vaccinations

##### **Booster vaccination (third time) against COVID-19 has started**

**You should receive a vaccination if at all possible to prevent severe disease.**

A vaccine voucher will be sent before your scheduled vaccination period to promote early vaccination. Starting from March, vaccination is available for people of all ages "after a lapse of six months since receiving the second vaccination". As the time when vouchers are mailed may change depending on when your second shot was, please confirm by calling the COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center or checking the Nara City website. People who have vouchers can make reservations.

### Vaccination for 5 to 11 year old children begins

#### Please consider receiving a vaccination with your child

We would like to ask both parents and children to read carefully the leaflet which will be sent to those eligible people, and understand both positive points (such as infection prevention) as well as negative points (such as side effects) of the vaccination before deciding whether to receive it or not.

#### Vaccination vouchers will be sent to all eligible people

(Children who will be turning five will be sent vouchers the month after their birthday.)

\*Please confirm details on the document enclosed in the vaccination voucher, or check the City website.

**Implementation Period:** Until Sept. 30 (Fri), 2022 (planned)

**Vaccine:** Manufactured by Pfizer (for children's use)

**Times of Vaccination:** Two times (3-week interval)

**How to Receive a Vaccination:** Vaccination by individual medical institutions

## Preliminary Examination Leaflets were Sent in Late March (to Those Born in February 2022)

If you bring the preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, and Health Insurance Card or other ID, you can receive vaccinations. If you have not received the preliminary examination leaflet due to moving into the city, etc., call Kenko Zoshin-Ka (Health Care Section). Tel. 0742-34-5129

## Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for Those Born in April 2019)

We recommend that your child receive the first term vaccination (the first two times and a one-time booster). Please confirm their vaccination status on the preliminary examination leaflet.

**Those Eligible:** Between age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday.

**Method:** The first vaccination are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second.

**Things to bring:** Preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook* and your child's ID document.

\*Those who are not registered as residents of Nara City are not eligible.

**Stomach Cancer Examination:** X-Ray (involving drinking barium on that day)

**Lung Cancer Examination:** Chest-X Ray (including tuberculosis test)

**Fee:** 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach cancer examination only and 500 yen for lung cancer examination only)  
600 yen as an additional fee for sputum test based on a general check-up for lung cancer (postage might need to be paid).

**Those Eligible:** 40 years old and over. Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible) are excluded.

**Others:** For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.
