Please Cooperate in the Proper Separation and Disposal of Garbage.

Since last December, there have been three fires involving garbage trucks, probably caused by the explosion of cartridge-type gas cylinders and rechargeable batteries for robot cleaners. We would like to remind you of the proper way to dispose of garbage to avoid serious disasters.

Insecticide, Spray Paint and Hair Mousse Cans: Collected as unburnable garbage Cartridge-type Gas Cylinders and Body Spray Cans: Collected as recyclable resources

(When disposing of cans, use up all the contents and make several holes in the can.)

Disposable Lighters: Collected as burnable garbage (When disposing of lighters, use up all the gas.)

Batteries, Button batteries, Coin Batteries: Insulate with tape and put them in the city's

battery collection boxes. The locations of these are shown on Nara City's website. $\cdots \rightarrow$

Batteries can also be collected as noxious garbage.

Small Rechargeable Batteries, Such as Mobile Batteries and Lithium-ion Batteries:

Use the city's battery collection boxes mentioned above, or the recycling boxes* in electronics retail stores.

Information about the New Corona (COVID-19) Vaccination Service

This is important information about the vaccination. If you are not vaccinated and need vaccinations against the new coronavirus, please read the information carefully and make a reservation as soon as possible.

Please see the up-to-date information on the Nara City Website. \rightarrow



The new Corona vaccination service for fiscal year 2023 will end on March 31(Sun.).

Those eligible: All people who finished the primary vaccination (5 years of age and older who have completed the 1st and 2ned doses; 6 months to 4 years of age who have completed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd doses)

Kind of vaccination: Against Omicron XBB. 1.5

How to get vaccinated: Individual vaccines are given out at various medical institutions.

If you have not received or lost your vaccination vouchers: You can apply

via "e-Koto Nara" (electronic application), by phone to the Call Center, by visiting the office, or by mail.

^{*}If you apply after the middle of March, you might not get vaccinations by March 31 due to the deadline.

^{*}Vouchers for this fiscal year will not be usable in fiscal 2024.

The New Corona Vaccination Will Become Regular and Generally Charge Fees from April 1 (Mon.) in 2024

Special and temporary vaccinations will stop being offered on March 31 (Sun.). Vaccination will become the same as flu vaccinations and fees will generally be charged, although vaccinations had been free.

If it is not possible to complete the primary vaccination by March 31 in 2024, a fee will be charged after that date.

Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for Those Born in March 2021)

Notice of 2024 Rabies Prevention Group Injections

Rabies Shots Should be Given Once a Year to Every Dog Older than 91 Days.

Things to Bring: The notification postcard (three-ticket type)
*It will be sent at around the end of March.

Fee: 3,400 yen (cash only)

Caution:

- Some dogs may not be allowed to receive the shot due to their physical condition.
- Dogs must be collared and brought by a person who is accustomed to handling them.
- If your dog cannot receive the shot at the site, please get it at an animal hospital.
- Please use public transportation as much as possible since some sites may not have enough parking.

For Those Who Have Not Registered

Dog registration is an important once-in-a-lifetime procedure for each dog as stipulated by the Rabies Prevention Law. Please register your dog before you go to the venue site as it will be very crowded on the day.

Breast Cancer: Develop the habit of breast awareness.

Cervical Cancer: It can be prevented with the HPV vaccine.

Endometrial Cancer: Check for abnormal bleeding. If there is anything of concern, please seek medical attention immediately.

Get Regular Osteoporosis Checkups

Osteoporosis is a disease in which bone mass decreases and bones become weaker, making them more prone

to fractures. It is especially common in postmenopausal women and is said to be closely related to the decrease in female hormones and aging.

Nara City health checkups are conducted every five years for those aged 40 to 70.

Increases in Female-Specific Cancers

Please be sure to have * a medical checkups once every two years.

* Cancer examinations for fiscal year 2023 finished at the end of February. They will start again from July 1, 2024

Do You Know about Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD)?

Chronic kidney disease is a condition in which kidney function decreases to less than 60% of that of healthy people (GFR is under 60ml/min/1.73m³), or kidney abnormalities that produce proteinuria continue.

Once a kidney gets damaged, it is difficult for it to return to its original state naturally.
