Timeline of the Trajectory of Tomio-Maruyama Tumulus

First Survey in 2017

It turned out to be the largest circular mound diameter 109m.

Third Survey in 2019

Some splinters of copper mirrors made in China were discovered by citizens participating in an excavation experience on the top of the mound.

6th Survey in 2022

The oldest and largest *Jyakoken* (an iron sword) in Japan (picture below) and a huge shield-shaped bronze mirror (left picture) with a serpentine dragon pattern were unearthed.

Survey Results

- * It was discovered how to build a clay coffin.
- * The wooden coffin with a total length of 5.6 m and the width of 64-70 cm was excavated.
- * Part of the inside of the wooden coffin was dyed bright red with mercury vermilion.
- * Three mirrors and nine combs were found in the wooden coffin as secondary funeral goods.

It is important to promote separating the garbage and reducing the amount of it, that we can do in our daily lives. Nara City will distribute “Miscellaneous paper storage bags (*Zatsugami hokan bukuro*)” with monthly City Information. Along with that, the City will also explain how to make use of “the miscellaneous storage bags” and the newly installed “miscellaneous collection boxes.”

Please reconsider how we separate our garbage.



What is “Miscellaneous Paper”?

Recyclable paper, like newspapers, magazines, cardboards and milk cartons are important material for making newly recycled - cardboard and other paper products.

About Garbage Collection

Please let us know when newly purchasing or replacing a garbage collection box.

Some boxes may not be able to be used smoothly depending on their shape, etc., as be sure to contact us before purchasing or installing a new garbage collection box. Please note that installation costs are to be borne by the user.

Temporary large amounts of garbage, due to moving and so on, are not collected by Nara City.

Bring them to Kankyo-Seibi Kojo (Environment Sanitation Plant) after making a reservation or ask an agent with a General Waste Collection and Transportation permit in Nara City to dispose of them. (You will be charged a fee by the agent.)

Japanese Encephalitis Vaccinations to Start (for Those Born in April 2021)

Those Eligible: Between age 3 to one day before the 7-1/2-year birthday.

Method: The first two vaccinations are 1 to 4 weeks apart, and an additional vaccination is given one year after the second shot.

Things to bring: Preliminary examination leaflet, *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook* and Health Insurance Card or other ID.

* Those who are not registered as residents of Nara City are not eligible.

Application: Make an appointment at one of the registered medical facilities listed on the city website.

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

Swelling of the parotid gland, pain, and fever are the main symptoms of mumps. In rare cases, mumps may cause "sensory-neural hearing loss". We have no effective means to cure it, so it is very important to get a vaccination.

Eligibility: For those who have a residence certificate in Nara City on the day and who are from **one year of age** until one day before **two years of age**. Those who had mumps are excluded.

We cannot refund the fee if your child has been vaccinated already.

Subsidies: 3,000 yen

Place: The registered medical facilities listed on the city website. You cannot receive the subsidy if you get another facility.

Application: Please fill out the application form at the registered medical facilities. (They have the application forms. Advance application is not necessary.) You will pay 3,000 yen less than the inoculation fee.

Things to Bring: *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, Child's ID to identify the child as a citizen of Nara City

Caution ! Mumps vaccination is **voluntary**. Guardians must understand **its purpose and side-effects**, and **make an educated decide whether your child should get it or not**.
