### The General Account for FY2023 finished 3.75 billion yen in the black

The revenue of the general account was 140 million yen smaller, and the expenditure was 290 million yen more than that of last year respectively.

**Others:** For those who are breastfeeding, please inform us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases where you may not be able to have the examination depending on your physical condition or medical consultation on the day.
