Public Transportation for Tomorrow

These days, especially after the pandemic, there are fewer buses and trains, and even worse, some of their lines and routes have been discontinued due to declining ridership and other reasons. Based on this situation, Nara City has implemented some measures in order to ensure people have access to transportation.

With the help of subsidies provided from the city, some stations along the Kintetsu and JR West lines have installed elevators, benches and family bathrooms, making them more passenger-friendly.

In addition, the city provides “taxi tickets” for pregnant women, which makes it easier for them to visit medical facilities, etc. It also supports introducing large low-floor buses that makes getting on and off easier.

The tickets are available this year.

- * One phone application for waste is only for one day. If you wish to bring in more than one lot of waste per day, please make an appropriate number of applications for that day. Your application may not be accepted depending on the application situation.
- * Applications from Dec. 29 (Sun.) through 31 (Tues.) and Jan. 6 must be done by Dec. 27 (Fri.)

Garbage Collection

Please cooperate in separating and disposing of your garbage appropriately to prevent fires.

Dispose of insecticide, spray paint and hair mousse cans as unburnable garbage. Dispose of cartridge-type gas cylinders and body spray cans as recyclable resources. (Please use up the contents of spray cans and make several holes in them.)

Batteries can be collected as noxious garbage or taken to a hub collection site. (Button batteries can be put in recovery boxes located within shops.)

Bring rechargeable batteries, such as mobile batteries and lithium ion batteries, to the recycle boxes placed inside electronics retail stores. The location of recycle boxes are shown on the JBRC web site.

Use up all the gas in disposable lighters and put them out as burnable garbage.

The Road Traffic Act Was Partially Revised on November 1th

1. Driving and abetting a bicycle under the influence of alcohol

Imprisonment of up to 3 years or a fine of up to 500,000 yen both the violator and the bicycle provider.

Those who provide alcohol and passengers are subject to imprisonment of up to 2 years or a fine of up to 300,000 yen.

2. Using a smartphone while riding a bicycle

Violators are subject to imprisonment of up to 6 months or a fine of up to 100,000 yen.

If violators create a danger, they are subject to imprisonment of up to 1 year or a fine of up to 300,000 yen.

About Deer in Nara Park

Deer in Nara are wild animals that have inhabited the area for more than 1300 years. The history of the wild deer's coexistence with humans has been evaluated, and the deer have been designated as a national natural monument.

Be cautious when you are near deer

Take good care of deer: The deer are a national natural monument. Don't hit or chase them.

* Can be penalized by law

Watch out for injuries: As deer are wild animals, they may rush forward to strike with their antlers. Don't touch them carelessly or let children approach them alone. In addition, in the spring, the female deer after giving birth are nervous about protecting their fawns. In autumn, the male deer become aggressive and may attack people due to the mating season.

Pay attention to your belongings: Deer may eat your belongings such as plastic bags, maps, and pamphlets in your hands. Please be careful because deer antlers may catch hold of your bag, etc.

On-Matsuri Festival of Kasuga Wakamiya Shrine

The *On-Matsuri* Festival is a festival of Wakamiya Shrine, which is inside Kasuga Taisha Shrine. This is a representative festival of Nara: starting with *Owatari shiki*, many Shinto rites and events are held, and many people visit Nara to see it. The origin of the festival dates back to 1136. Since then, the festival has been held every year without interruption. It will be held for the 889th time this year. The *On-Matsuri* Festival's ritual entertainments are designated as an Important Intangible Folk Cultural Heritage as part of traditional Japanese culture and customs handed down from the past.

* The rituals of *Senko-no-gi* and *Kanko-no-gi* are performed in complete darkness without any light. No photography is allowed.

* Rituals, events, and the schedule may be partially changed.

Oh-shukusho-sai: *Oh-shukusho* is the place where *Yamato zamurai*, who are dedicated to the festival, lived in seclusion and prayed in rituals for the successful completion of the festival.

Senko-no-gi/Akatsuki-sai: At midnight on Dec. 17 (Sun.), the soul of the god travels from Wakamiya Shrine in Kasuga Taisha Shrine to the *Otabi-sho* temporary shrine. In darkness, *gagaku* is played. With torches and incense in front, the procession along the approach feels otherworldly. Arriving at *Otabisho*, *Akatsukisai* begins, offering the morning food while mediums dance *kagura*.

Owatari-shiki: The parade is full of traditional costumes and customs from the Heian era to the Edo era. The groups perform various entertainments dedicated to the god in front of “*Yogou no matsu*” (beyond the first *Torii*) and then go ahead to *Otabisho*.

Otabisho-sai: On Dec. 17 (Sun.) from 14:30 to around 22:30 on the stage in the *Otabisho* site, *Kagura*, *Dengaku*, *Sarugaku* and *Bugaku* are performed one after another. These arts came to Japan through the Silk Road and then matured as traditional arts.

Kanko-no-gi: After finishing *Otabisho sai*, by midnight on Dec. 18 (Mon.), the god’s soul again returns to Wakamiya Shrine.
