2025 is a Census Year

The census is the most important statistical survey in Japan for all people and households living in Japan.

Due date: October 1 (Wed.)

Those eligible: All people and households living in Japan (including foreigners)

Method: Staff will visit households and distribute the documents.

Contents: Data related to household members: Gender, date of birth, type of employment, etc.

: Data related to households: Type of household, type of residence, type house construction, etc.

About Garbage Collection

Please let us know when purchasing or replacing a garbage collection box.

Some boxes may not be able to be used smoothly depending on their shape, etc., so be sure to contact us before purchasing or installing a new garbage collection box. Please note that installation costs are to be borne by the user.

Temporary large amounts of garbage, due to moving and so on, are not collected by Nara City.

Bring them to Kankyo-Seibi Kojo (Environment Sanitation Plant) after making a reservation or ask an agent with a General Waste Collection and Transportation permit in Nara City to dispose of them. (You will be charged a fee by the agent.)

Spring Traffic Safety Campaign in Nara Prefecture

1. Keep the Roads Safe and Traffic Accident-Free, “Let’s Improve Traffic Manners.”

Protect yourself from “Internal Bleeding Caused by Infectious Colon Diseases” (Such as O-157)

The Nature of Infectious Colon Diseases that Cause Internal Bleeding & Main Infection Routes

You might get infected by eating raw or insufficiently heated meat such as liver. Infection can spread from person to person via toilets, shared towels, etc. Their incubation period is 3-8 days. In the human body, they can cause serious damage to kidney, brain, etc.

Prevention

- Meat should be cooked thoroughly. Use separate pairs of chopsticks for cooking and eating.
- Wash your hands well with soap before and after cooking, and before eating.
- Wash cooking equipment and kitchen utensils diligently and sterilize them.
- Try to eat as soon as possible after cooking.

The following people are excluded: Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past 5 years or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in this or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a lung cancer low dose CT scan by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

Nara City will Subsidize a Part of the Fee That You Pay for Vaccination Against Mumps

Swelling of the parotid gland, pain, and fever are the main symptoms of mumps. In rare cases mumps may cause "sensory-neural hearing loss". We have no effective means to cure it. It is very important to get a vaccination.

Eligibility: For those who have a residence certificate in Nara City on the day and who are from one year of age until one day before two years of age. Those who have had mumps are excluded. We cannot refund the fee if your child has been vaccinated already.

Subsidy: 3,000 yen

Place: The registered medical facilities listed on the city website. You cannot receive the subsidy if you are vaccinated at another facility.

Things to bring: *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook*, Child's ID (to identify the child as a citizen of Nara City)

Application: Please fill out the application form at the registered medical facilities. (They have the application forms. Advance application is not necessary.) You will pay 3,000 yen less than the inoculation fee.

Caution! Mumps vaccination is voluntary. Guardians must understand its purpose and side-effects, and make an educated decision about whether your child should get it or not.
