LET'S GO TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES!

Nara is the place where Japan's first public library "*Un-tei*" was constructed. Today we have three city libraries and 80,000 users. But this is only around 20% of all the population. As the birthplace of public libraries, Nara City is promoting various measures to improve convenience for visitors by operating mobile libraries, extending the opening hours of the existing three facilities, and setting a book return box at nearby train stations.

 Boasts of the best location, commanding a beautiful view of historical Kofukuji Temple. One whole floor of this two-storied facility is full of 120,000 books for kids.

Mobile Libraries, Good for Parents with Kids and Senior Citizens

Nara City has a service of mobile libraries, where even newcomers are able to borrow books, by showing an ID card such as a driving license. You can keep books at home for one month, as opposed to only two weeks at regular libraries.

Eligibility: Qualifying households meet all three requirements below:

- 1, The household's third (or more) baby was born between April 1, 2018 and March 31, 2019.
- 2, The baby was registered with Nara City Jumin Kihon Daicho (Basic Residents Register) when they were born.
- 3, The older children should not have turned 18 by March 31, after the third (or more) baby was born.

Period for Application: From June 1(Fri.),

Please apply within six months after the third (or more) baby was born.

Apply once for each eligible baby.

Please apply for the points when you apply for "Nyuyoji Iryo-hi Jyukyu Sikakusho (Certificates for Medical Expenses Support for Babies)" according to the Medical Expenses Support System for Children. If you have already applied for "Nyuyoji Iryo-hi Jyukyu Sikakusho", please apply for the points with the baby's Health Insurance Card and your ID (such as driver's license) during the period, to Kodomo Ikusei-Ka (Child Allowance Section), Shutcho-sho (Branch Offices), or Gyosei (Administration) Center.

Procedures to Apply for Water Charge Deductions Will Start on June 21 (Thurs.)

Nara City will send applications to those whose water charge deduction was already confirmed. Please fill in the form and send it back. In case you do not receive an application by the end of June, please contact Okyakusama Center in the Enterprise Bureau.

Japanese or foreigners who are registered citizens of Nara City and fulfill the below-mentioned

conditions will be able to get a partial water charge deduction, if applied for and duly approved. (Those who receive livelihood subsidies or livelihood assistance, such as for Japanese war orphans who returned to Japan from China, are excluded.)

Reception Time: 9:30-12:00, 13:00-16:00

Place: Okyakusama (Customer) Center in the Kigyo-Kyoku (Enterprise Bureau)

Deduction Period: From the month the application for deduction is approved until July of the next year. Application for renewal shall be made each year.

*Please apply by July 20 (Fri.) for the deduction from this August.

Eligibility: Households whose meter diameters are between 13 and 25 mm and who have a total family income as mentioned below. (Nontaxable income included.)

How to Get the Deduction: The amount above will be deducted from your water charge each month. For those who live in a housing complex where the water charge is paid collectively, the total deduction amount will be refunded after confirming the payment during the deduction period through submitting proper receipts.

Documents Required:

1. Residence certificates for the whole household (showing members' relationships)

- 2. Income certificates for all household members
- **3.** For those who have nontaxable income (such as a bereaved-family pension, disability pension or employment insurance), papers or their copies which confirm the amount
- * (1) and (2) are not needed if you were a resident of Nara City as of Jan. 1, 2018 and can sign and put your seal on a form to consent to apply for water charge deduction.
- **Application**: Fill in the application form available from the Okyakusama Center in the Enterprise Bureau (also downloadable from the Enterprise Bureau Website), and visit the Center with your seal, required documents, and a form of identification (a driver's license or national health insurance card).

School Expenses Assistance for school supplies and school lunches for elementary and junior high school students will be provided according to the below-mentioned standards. Applicants should submit the application to Kyoiku-Somu-Ka (General Affairs Section of the Board of Education), branch offices, administration centers, or the municipal schools which your children attend between June 1 (Fri.) and June 29 (Fri.). For those who wish to continue on from the previous year, re-application is required.

All three times (the first, the second and the booster) of the first term vaccination can be gotten. (Confirm with the Preliminary Examination Leaflet.)

The Period of Vaccination: Between age 3 and one day before the 7-1/2 years old birthday **Vaccination Schedule**:

Initial Vaccination: Two times, with an interval of one to four weeks

Booster Vaccination: Once, with an interval of one year after the completion of the initial vaccinations.

Japanese Encephalitis (the second term): Those Born in April 2009

Postcards with guidance will be sent. *Mother's and Child's Health Handbook* and the Health Insurance Card, etc. are needed to get vaccinations.

Be Careful about Infectious Diseases Spread by Mosquitoes

These include dengue fever, zika virus, etc. Refer to the City website concerning prevalent are and prevention, etc.

Prevention Points

1) To Prevent Breeding of Mosquitoes: Frequent cleaning and getting rid of standing water in order not to grow mosquito larva.

2) Don't Get Bitten by Mosquitoes: Wear long sleeved shirts and full-length pants for outside activities. Use mosquito repellent.

If you go abroad, collect infection information on the area you will travel to.

If you have a fever, headache, joint pain, a rash, etc. after returning home from the areas where dengue fever, zika virus or other infectious diseases are prevalent, please consult a doctor.

Fee: 1,500 yen (1,000 yen for stomach examination only, 500 yen for lung examination only).600 yen as additional fee for a sputum test based on a general check-up for lung cancer.(Postage might need to be paid.)

- Those Eligible: 40 years old and over, except those who are pregnant; had stomach, lung or bowel surgery in the past or those organs are currently being treated (for further details, contact Kenko Zoshin-Ka); have barium sensitivity or have accidentally swallowed it (for those, the lung cancer exam is possible); or had the Nara City stomach cancer examination with an endoscope in FY 2017 (for those, the lung cancer exam is possible).
- **Others:** If you are breastfeeding a baby, please notify us of such when you apply. The interval for examinations is once a year. You might not be able to have an examination depending on your physical condition or the results of the general check-up on the day.

Assistance for Those Who Need Help Evacuating

As part of the Disaster Countermeasures Basic Act amended in June 2013, a list of residents who need assistance in disaster evacuation (elderly citizens, people with disabilities, infants and people who need special care at a disaster-prevention facility) has been established.

Nara City created the list of residents who need assistance in 2015.

Who Are People Who Need Assistance in Disaster Evacuation in Nara City?

Those who would have difficulty evacuating by themselves in a disaster, and those who need assistance to evacuate smoothly and speedily.

Those Who Need Assistance in Evacuation

Those who live at their home and fall into any of the categories below

- 1. Those who have the Physical Disability Certificate 1 degree or 2 based on the Physically Disabled Persons Welfare Act
- 2. Those who have the Rehabilitation Certificate A1 or A2 based on the Prefectural Implementation Guidance for the Certificate
- 3. Those who have the Mental Disability Certificate 1 degree or 2 based on the laws concerning mental health and welfare for the mentally disabled
- 4. Among recipients of the former Specified Diseases Treatment Research Project, those who have been certified as severely diseased or equivalent
- 5. Those who have been certified as needing level 3 of care or over based on the Long Term Care Insurance Act
- 6. Those whom Nara's Mayor has approved as recipients of special assistance. (Those who need special care, but do not fall into categories 1 to 5 above, and will have difficulty evacuating by themselves.)

* Those who need special care and have difficulty in evacuating by themselves are asked to consult with people in charge, and submit an application form together with their advisory opinion. Proxy applications will be accepted.

What Is in The List

1. Name, 2. Date of birth, 3. Gender, 4. Address or whereabouts, 5. Phone number and other contact number, 6. Why evacuation support is necessary, 7. Name of the neighborhood community association, 8. Whether you agree with providing personal information to people in charge, 9. Other items which the Mayor approves of as necessary (Emergency contact number, level of care needed and physical location of disabilities)

We Would Like to Ask You to Agree with Providing Personal Information

About the list established by Nara City, for those who did not reply by the end of last year and those who have newly become protectable in evacuation, we are asking your agreement in providing personal information.

Those eligible people will receive a letter asking for agreement from December. Information about those who have agreed will be used for watching over daily life, assistance in evacuation, safety confirmation and rescue.

*People in charge: Disaster related sections at City Hall, fire stations, police stations, the social welfare council, neighborhood community associations, volunteer fire companies, autonomous disaster and crime prevention organizations, local welfare workers, children's social workers, and other community supporters.

Points of Attention

If you do not inform us of any changes about personal information, your agreement will be automatically renewed, and you do not have to submit the agreement again. When you do not confirm your agreement or if there are some changes in contents (for example, entering a welfare facility or moving to another house), please be sure to contact us.

*Evacuation assistance in disasters will be provided as part of community activities when it is possible. There is no legal responsibility or duty to carry out in such activities.

In the event of disaster or threat of disaster, protecting the lives of evacuees who need assistance is the priority. Also personal information will be provided to people in charge if necessary within the extent necessary.

Information for Disaster Prevention Will Be Provided by Nara City via Yahoo! Disaster Prevention News Flush (Smartphone app)

In order to deliver information more speedily and correctly in disasters, local municipalities have started providing emergency information by using "Yahoo! Disaster Prevention News Flush", Yahoo! JAPAN's notification app. We will use it to deliver information such as opening/closure of evacuation centers, etc. from now on.

Be Careful of Floods Disaster During the Rainy Season

In recent years unexpected localized torrential rain has caused damage throughout Japan. Everyone has to be cautious about rain damage and landslides as well. In order to keep the damage to a minimum, each person must always be cautious and prepared.

Always:

- Pay special attention to Disaster Prevention Information published by the local meteorological office and use it to avoid damage
- Prepare an emergency food supply and kits in advance in case of electric power outages, water supply stoppages, and evacuation.
- Check around your house. If you find anything abnormal about roof, rain gutters, shutters, windows, exterior walls, etc., make sure to repair and reinforce that area.

When Sudden Torrential Rain Starts:

- Be aware of signs of landslide such as, cracks and distortion on the slope, stoppage of underground or spring water flow, unusual sounds and smells, and overflow of turbid water.
- On evacuation, wear comfortable clothes and try to act in a group with at least two people. (If it is dark outside and flooding has already started, do not risk going outside, but to remain in places such as rooms on the 2nd floor or elevated areas which can be secured safely.)
- During evacuation, avoid river banks, cliffside roads, and underground paths.
- Be very careful because side ditch covers and maintenance hatches may be out of place.
