News from Shimin-Ka (Residential Affairs Section)

The family register system will be revised and names will be given reading kana.

Notification letters will be sent by the municipalities where residents' permanent domiciles are located between May 26 and August 31. In case the reading kana for the name is incorrect, please correct it on the Myna portal website or at the nearest city hall office. If the reading kana is correct, nothing needs to be done. The notified reading kana will be added to the family register on May 26, 2026.

Due to the updating of the computer system in connection with the above revision, services for citizens will be suspended as follows:

- (1) **The civic service center** will be closed on May 17 (Sat.).
- (2) **All services for citizens at convenience stores**, such as certificate issuance and user registration applications, will be suspended on May 21 (Wed.).

Rubella Antibody Examination

Maternal infection with the rubella virus during early pregnancy may cause Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) in the baby.

Date: From May 1 (Thurs.) to Feb. 28 (Sat.), 2026

Eligibility: Those who will be registered as Nara City citizens on the examination day; and who are women planning a pregnancy or family members living with a woman whose antibody titer is 16 times and under according to an HI test (hemagglutination inhibition test) or under 8.0 according to EIA (enzyme immunoassay).

*Excluding those who have already had a rubella examination, have been vaccinated against rubella twice, have suffered from rubella, or are currently pregnant.

Those eligible: A person over the age of 40 who is registered as a resident in Nara City on that day.

The following people are excluded: Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past 5 years or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in this or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a lung cancer low dose CT scan by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.
