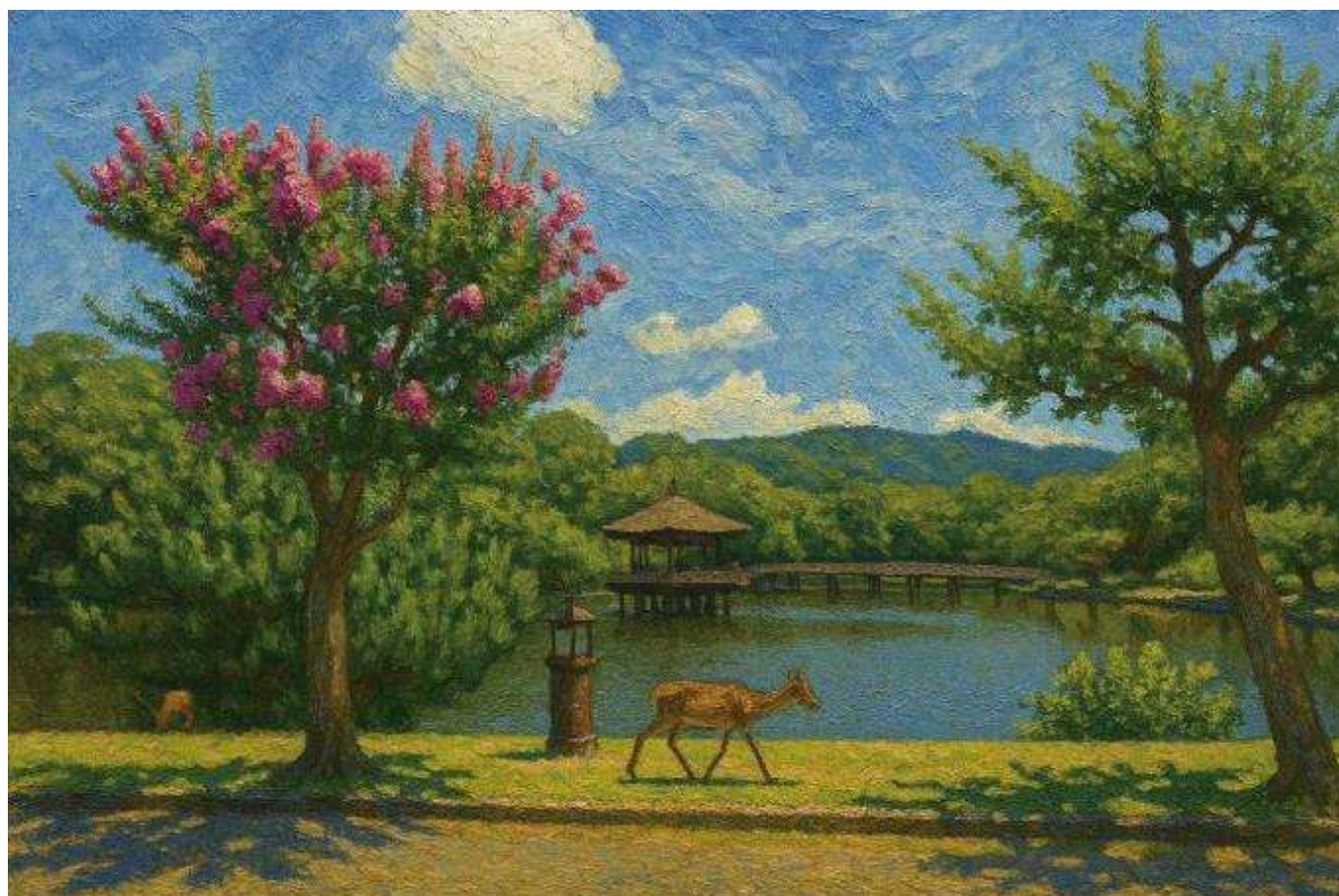

Pruned branches should be cut into pieces less than 5cm in diameter and 30cm in length. Please apply to dispose of them as bulky household waste pickup or carry-in waste.

## **August is Food Sanitation Awareness Month Beware of Food Poisoning**

### **Precautions for Campylobacter and Enterohemorrhagic E. coli (O157, etc.)**

- (1) Do not consume raw or undercooked meat.
- (2) Use separate chopsticks for cooking and eating, separate knives and cutting boards for different foods and avoid letting meat juices come into contact with other foods.

### **Be Cautious of Fish Parasites such as Anisakis**

- (1) Anisakis commonly parasitizes fish such as mackerel and horse mackerel.
- (2) Choose fresh fish and promptly remove the internal organs.
- (3) Perform sufficient freezing or thorough cooking.

### **Three Principles of Food Poisoning Prevention**

- (1) Prevent Contamination: Wash hands thoroughly before cooking and eating. / Thoroughly wash cooking utensils.
- (2) Prevent Bacterial Growth: Store food promptly in the refrigerator or freezer. / Avoid leaving cooked food at room temperature for long periods.
- (3) Kill Bacteria: Cook food thoroughly (center temperature of 75°C / 167°F or higher for at least 1 minute).

600 yen as an additional fee for sputum tests based on a general check-up for lung cancer (Postage might  
need to be paid.)

**Those eligible:** A person over the age of 40 who is registered as a resident in Nara City on that day.

The following people are ineligible: Pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery  
within the past 5 years or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung  
cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer checks by Nara City in this  
or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a low dose CT scan  
for lung cancer by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

**Others:** For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply.

The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the  
examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

These are all symptoms of heat stroke. In recent years, there has been an increase in the number of people transported by ambulance in the city. Everyone, be careful.

**Preventive Measures against Heat Stroke**


**1. Prevent dehydration: A person needs about 2.5 liters of water per day**

1.0L from meals + 0.3L of metabolic water (water produced when food is broken down in the body)  
+ 1.2L from drinking water (about 7 to 8 cups in a glass)

\* Diet is an important means of hydration. Don't skip breakfast and eat three meals.



**2. Prevent a rise in body temperature:**

Continued daily exercise can promote sweating and reduce the rise in body temperature.

**When exercising:** Take moderate breaks and stay hydrated. Pay attention to your physical condition and clothing, and do not overdo it. If you feel unwell, **get treatment as soon as possible.**
