

Current Situation of Garbage Disposal in Nara City

As far as we live, we cannot go without creating garbage.

What happens after we threw them away?

What Is the Situation of Garbage in the City?

The Haikibutsu-Taisaku-Ka (Waste Management Section), the Shushu-Ka (Collection Section) and the Bika-Suishin-Ka (Keep-the-City-Beautiful Section) are located at the Kankyo-Seibi Center (Waste Management Center). So this center comprehensively deals with garbage disposal. Their work is indispensable for our daily life.

Q1. Is the volume of garbage increasing?

A1. No, it has been decreasing year after year.

Since March 1999, when the current measures of garbage separation were introduced, the total amount of garbage collected has declined after peaking in 1998, from 140,000 tons in 1998 to 91,000 tons in 2016.

This means that garbage separation has led to recycling of garbage. However, we can still decrease the amount even more by promoting separation of recyclable garbage.

Q2. What is the greatest amount of burnable garbage?

A2.. Paper garbage and food waste account for about 70 percent.

About 90 percent of waste is burnable. Also, much of it is recyclable paper and unconsumed food. According to the 2017 survey conducted by Nara City, paper waste account for 39 percent and uneaten food 36 percent of burnable waste. Please keep "making less waste" in mind.

Garbage Disposal at The Center

About 248 tons of garbage is brought to the center in a day, about 90,000 tons a year. By incinerating them from 850°C to 900°C, they are reduced to 1/20 in volume and 1/7 in weight. Toxic substances caused during incineration are processed by using filters and catalysts, and released safely. The collected burned ash is used for landfill. The total amount is about 24.5 tons a day, 8,940 tons a year.

What Problems Does The Center Have & What We Should Do from Now On? Ageing of The Incinerators & Less Efficiency

Working for more than 30 years after construction, the four incinerators are aging rapidly recently. Additionally, one of them does not meet quake-resistance standards. The total amount of incineration was 480 tons in total at the beginning of their operation, but because of aging the amount has fallen to 300 tons, or 60 percent of the early days.

1.25 Billion Yen for Maintenance

An incinerator is composed of various parts. As it has a delicate structure, even when only one part is broken, the whole machine must be stopped and inspected. Periodically the incinerators are dismantled, checked, overhauled and repaired for better operation. Consequently, their maintenance costs 1.25 billion yen a year. Actually, more repairs are needed as they get older.

Less Garbage Enables Longer Use of The Incinerators

Today Nara City has a plan to construct a new center for disposal. However, it will take at least 10 years to be completed. So, we have to use the incinerators carefully. Separating garbage and reducing the amount will help make the incinerators' running time shorter, causing minimum damage to them. Through such efforts we will be able to use them longer. Please keep "Separation and Reduction" in mind when you put garbage out.

Special Allowance for Severely Challenged or Elderly Foreigners / Ex-foreigners

Nara City will pay a special allowance (20,000 yen/month) as follows to extend social welfare services.

Special Allowance for Severely Challenged or Elderly Foreigners / Ex-foreigners

Those Eligible: Foreigners or ex-foreigners who, as of January 1, 1982 had registered their residence in Japan, had already been determined to be eligible as severely mentally and physically challenged*(1), and had already reached 20 years of age; however, those who fit into the following categories are excluded:

- 1) Those who are on public welfare, or receive *chugoku zanryu hojin tou shien kyufu-kin* (support benefits for Japanese nationals left behind in China),
- 2) Those who are in social institutions,
- 3) Those who have been receiving public benefits of 240,000 yen or more annually *(2),
- 4) Those who earned more than the limit for the disability basic pension (annual sum) in 2017.

Notes

- *(1) Shintai shogaisha techo (Physical Disability Certificate) holders (1 to 3 degrees) or Ryoiku techo (Mental Retardation Certificate) holders (degree A)
- *(2) For those who have been receiving public benefits of less than 240,000 yen annually, the amount of the benefits will be subtracted from the special allowance to be paid.

Special Allowance for Elderly Foreigners / Ex-foreigners

Those Eligible: Foreigners or ex-foreigners who were born before April 1, 1926, and had registered their residence in Japan as of January 1, 1982; however, those who fit into the following categories are excluded:

- 1) Those who are on public welfare, or receive support benefits for Japanese nationals left behind in China (*chugoku zanryu hojin tou shien kyufu-kin*),
- 2) Those who are in social institutions,
- 3) Those who have been receiving public benefits of 240,000 yen or more annually [see*(2) above],
- 4) Those who earned more than the limit for senior welfare pensions (annual sum) in 2016.
- 5) Those who receive a special allowance for severely challenged foreigners / ex-foreigners.

- *Those who have already been receiving this allowance are required to reapply with the required documents including renewal application forms, which will be sent to you.

NOTICES ----- from the National Health Insurance and Pension Section Renewal of Certificate of National Health Insurance, from August

(The form of the certificate will be renewed because the National Health Insurance system will change).

New certificates for all family members will be sent until the end of July by registered mail (except for those who are covered by insurance for those 75 years old and over).

Please check the content as soon as you receive it.

A certificate of short- term validity or the qualified card for National Health Insurance (not the certificate) might be issued for households which have been falling behind in paying expenses without a reasonable reason. When you use these cards at clinics or hospitals you will have to pay all the medical expenses.

Renewal of the Certificate of Your Highest-Limit Payment for Medical Treatment

The present certificates will expire at the end of July.

Notes (Please apply if you are eligible)

The highest-limit payment system for medical treatment might apply for those 70 years old and older from August, even though you have an income correspond to active working people (please check the brochure enclosed in the envelope about details).

The meal fee will be reduced for those who belong to households receiving residence tax exemption when they are hospitalized.

*The households below can't apply:

- 1, Households including family members who don't declare their residence tax though they have a Certificate of the National Health Insurance.
- 2, Households which have been falling behind in Insurance payments.

Renewal of Qualification Certificates for Medical Expenses Support for Single-parent Families
