Nara City's Account Settlement Information and Fiscal Condition for FY 2024

The General Account for FY 2024 finished 3.35 billion yen in the black.

The revenue of the general account was 6.47 billion yen more, and expenditures were 6.9 billion yen more than that of last year respectively. The general account for the fiscal year finished 3.35 billion yen in the black (excluding funds of about 820 million yen carried forward to the next fiscal year).
