Those Eligible: 40 years old and over, registered as Nara City residents on the examination day, except for:

pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past 5 years or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscopy for stomach cancer by Nara City in fiscal year 2024 or 2025 (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had low-dose CT screening for lung cancer by Nara City in fiscal year 2025 (stomach cancer examination is possible)

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please inform us of such when you apply.

The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases where you may not be able to have the examination depending on your physical condition or medical consultation on that day.
