--- Prepare for Emergencies ---

In emergencies, please help each other

When the massive earthquake struck Hanshin and Awaji areas in 1995, more than 90% of the trapped people were rescued through self and mutual help to each other.

What should you stockpile?

Prepare emergency toilets or portable toilet kits in advance, enough for five uses per day for one week.

--- about Disaster Evacuation Bags getting through the first day ---

Prepare daily necessities for temporary evacuation, according to your family situation, such as those listed below:

water and food, helmet, clothes, underwear and towels, rain gear, work gloves, toothbrushes, masks, sanitary goods, mobile storage batteries, a portable radio, emergency contact notes, cash (with coins), portable toilets, toilet paper, cold weather gear, hazard map, necessary items for children, etc.



Approximate weight of your evacuation bag:

15kg for men, 10kg for women, 6kg for the elderly and children

--- Things to prepare to get your family through the week after the disaster! ---

Use the “Tokyo Emergency Preparedness Navigator” to easily check the amount of food, water, and daily necessities your family will need!
(Click the Menu to see the site in English).

Have you taken measures to prevent furniture from tipping over?

- 1) Don't place tall furniture in rooms where you spend a lot of time, such as bedrooms or children's rooms.
- 2) When you place furniture, be sure it wouldn't block exits if overturned.
- 3) Make sure furniture is securely fastened to the wall.

Do you understand where dangerous places near your house are?

Check the safe route to the evacuation site with the hazard map in advance.

The Road Traffic Act will be revised, starting from April 1.

A traffic violation notification system (blue ticket) will be introduced for **bicycle traffic violations** committed by people aged 16 years and older. These violations will be subject to a blue ticket.

Serious violations such as drunk driving or obstructive driving on a bicycle will not be treated as minor offenses: they will continue to be handled through criminal procedures as before.

6 Tips for Residential Fire Prevention and Protecting Lives

- 1) Install heaters and gas or electric cookers with safety devices to prevent fire.
- 2) Check residential fire alarms regularly and replace them every 10 years.
- 3) Clear and tidy up rooms, and use fireproof products to prevent fires from spreading to bedding, clothing, etc.
- 4) Install fire extinguishers to put out fires before they spread and know how to use them.
- 5) Have evacuation routes and plans for the elderly and those who with disabilities
- 6) Participate in fire and disaster prevention drills, and take fire prevention measures in the local area through door-to-door visits, etc.

Annual Women's Health Week: March 1 to 8

Female-Specific Cancers: Young Women Are Also at Risk

Cervical Cancer: The number of cases increases sharply among women in their 20s. It develops without noticeable symptoms, but it can be prevented with the HPV vaccine.

Endometrial Cancer: Check for abnormal bleeding. If there is anything of concern, please seek medical attention immediately.

Breast Cancer: One in nine Japanese women develops breast cancer. Be mindful of your breast health, and if you notice any abnormalities, see a doctor immediately. Screening vouchers for cervical and breast cancer screenings are mailed to eligible individuals once every two years. Please be sure to attend your screenings regularly.

Get Regular Osteoporosis Checkups

Osteoporosis is a disease in which bones become weaker, making them more prone to fractures.

It is especially common in postmenopausal women. Regular medical checkups raise your awareness of bone mass changes and help prevent disease. Nara City osteoporosis checkups are conducted every five years for those aged 40 to 70.

* Medical checkups for the fiscal year 2025 finished at the end of February. They will start again from July 1, 2026.
