The Weather Alert System Will Change

Starting around the end of May (tentative), a new disaster-related weather information system will be used. Decide whether to evacuate based on the following 5-level evacuation alert system.

When to evacuate must be decided based on the Alert Level shown below.

If Alert Level 3 or 4 is announced, make sure to follow the evacuation order, etc. from the city, and check information about how dangerous your surroundings are and local river’s levels. If you are near a dangerous or hazardous area, make sure to evacuate as early as possible.

Alert Level	Alert Name	Actions to Take
1	Early warning information	Pay attention to disaster prevention weather information and begin to prepare yourself for the possibility of a disaster.
2	Advisory	Study hazard maps, etc., and reconfirm possible disaster risks assessment.
3	Alert	Begin evacuating elderly people who need more time to evacuate from hazardous areas. People who are not elderly must also prepare to evacuate as necessary.
4	Hazard Warning	Everyone must evacuate from hazardous places. If a strong windstorm is expected, evacuation must be completed before the windstorm starts.
5	Emergency Warning	Life-threatening situation. Move immediately to a safer place than where you are.

Let's Get Tested for Early Detection HIV Test Promotion Week June 1 (Mon.) to June 7 (Tues.)

It is essential to get tested for early detection of HIV infection.

Early detection leads to early initiation of treatment and prevention of the spread of infection. In Nara City, same-day HIV testing and testing for sexually transmitted diseases (HIV, syphilis, hepatitis) are conducted anonymously and free of charge.

Rubella Antibody Examination

Maternal infection with the rubella virus during early pregnancy may cause Congenital Rubella Syndrome (CRS) in the baby.

Date: From May 1 (Fri.) to Jan.31 (Sun.), 2027

Eligibility: Those who will be registered as Nara City citizens on the examination day, and

- (1) Women who are planning a pregnancy for the first time.
- (2) A spouse or other family members living with a woman planning a pregnancy
- (3) A spouse or other family members living with a pregnant woman whose antibody titer is 16 times and under according to an HI test (hemagglutination inhibition test) or under 8.0 according to EIA (enzyme immunoassay).

* Excluding those who have already had a rubella examination, have been vaccinated against rubella twice, have suffered from rubella, or are currently pregnant.

From FY 2026, sputum testing is not included in lung cancer examinations because the national guidelines were revised.

Those eligible: A person over the age of 40 who is registered as a resident in Nara City on that day.

The following people are excluded: pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past 5 years or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in this or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a lung cancer low dose CT scan by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

Nara City is home to nine cultural facilities offering a wide variety of cultural events and exhibitions. Many popular annual events are also held throughout the year. Take this opportunity to visit with your friends and family.

Museums & More

1. Irie Taikichi Memorial Museum of Photography Nara City

A serene photography museum showcasing the works of photographer Irie Taikichi, along with exhibitions by contemporary photographers.

2. Nara City Sugioka Kason Calligraphy Museum

A calligraphy museum named after Nara City Honorary Citizen Sugioka Kason. The white building blends beautifully into the Naramachi district. Workshops using traditional brushes are also offered.

3. Nara City Museum of Art

Features exhibitions that can be enjoyed by both adults and children, including displays of artwork created by local citizens.

4. Former Residence of Irie Taikichi

Located on the former grounds of Todaiji Temple, this is where Irie Taikichi lived from the postwar period until his passing. Visitors can get a glimpse into his work and personal connections at the time.

5. Onjo-Kan

As a new creative hub in Nara-machi, this venue hosts a wide variety of events, including music and theater performances.

6. Nara Centennial Hall

The architectural design of this magnificent hall was conceived with the image of a “ship of culture” in mind, and it was built with the hope of nurturing Nara’s culture and sharing it with the world.

The lawn area, which was renovated last year, has become a place of relaxation for the people of Nara.

7. Naramachi Center

This complex houses a civic hall and a public library, allowing visitors to enjoy the warm atmosphere created by the wood. The “Kotona Lab” on the first floor hosts a variety of creative workshops. Concerts and exhibitions are held in the entrance hall.

8. Seibu-Kaikan Civic Hall

This concert hall boasts excellent acoustics. It is available for piano concerts and recitals.

9. Hokubu-Kaikan Civic Hall

This hall is the perfect venue for music concerts and recitals. It also hosts a variety of cultural and fitness classes.

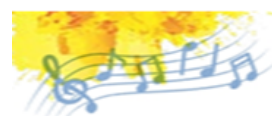
