August is Food Sanitation Awareness Month Beware of Food Poisoning

Precautions for Campylobacter and Enterohemorrhagic E. coli (O157, etc.)

- (1) Do not consume raw or undercooked meat.
- (2) Use separate chopsticks for cooking and eating, separate knives and cutting boards for different foods and avoid letting meat juices come into contact with other foods.

Be Cautious of Fish Parasites such as Anisakis

Anisakis commonly parasitizes fish such as mackerel and horse mackerel. Choose fresh fish and promptly remove the internal organs. Freeze completely, and cook thoroughly.

Three Principles of Food Poisoning Prevention

- (1) **Prevent Contamination:** Wash hands thoroughly before cooking and eating. Thoroughly wash cooking utensils.
- (2) **Prevent Bacterial Growth:** Store food promptly in the refrigerator or freezer. Avoid leaving cooked food at room temperature for long periods.
- (3) **Kill Bacteria:** Cook food thoroughly (to a center temperature of 75°C / 167°F or higher for at least 1 minute).

* From FY 2026, sputum testing is not included in lung cancer examinations because the national guidelines were revised.

Those eligible: A person over the age of 40 who is registered as a resident of Nara City on that day.

The following people are excluded: pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past one year or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in this or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a lung cancer low dose CT scan by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

Hydrate Frequently and Do Low-impact Exercise

Let's Be Careful to Avoid Heatstroke!

Request 1 Please avoid the heat.

Request 2 Try to stay hydrated after exercise or going out.

Request 3 Refrain from going outside when heat stroke (special) alerts are issued.

Heatstroke refers to various physical ailments caused by "heat."

Do you recognize these symptoms?

* Numbness in the limbs * Dizziness, lightheadedness * Muscle cramps * Feeling sick	* A pounding headache * Nausea, vomiting * Feeling sluggish * Consciousness is somehow strange	* Unconscious * Body twitching (convulsions) * Incoherent if spoken to * Can't walk straight * Their body is hot

Preventive Measures against Heat Stroke

1. Prevent dehydration:

A person needs about 2.5 liters of water per day.

Meals	1.0L
* Metabolic water	0.3L (* water produced when food is broken down in the body)
Drinking water	1.2L

Meals are an important way to stay hydrated, so eat three meals a day.

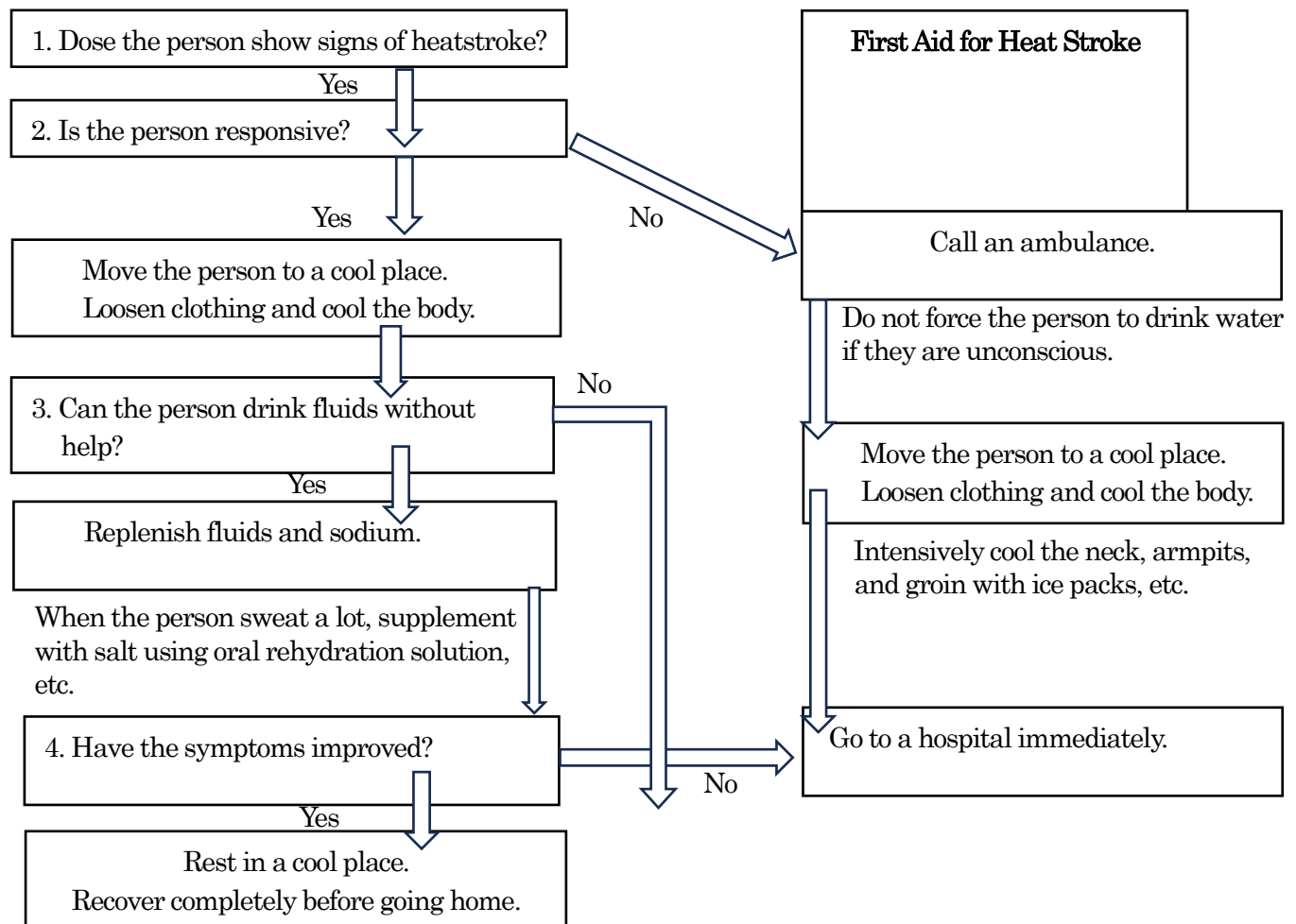
2. Prevent a rise in body temperature

Continuing daily exercise can promote sweating and reduce the rise in body temperature.

When exercising:

1. Exercise before it gets too hot, and stay within your physical limits.
2. Don't forget to stay hydrated.
3. Do about 30 minutes of moderately strenuous exercise every day in a slightly hot environment.

If someone get heat stroke,



Point: If there is no response, call an ambulance and move the person to a cool place. Cool their core body temperature.
