Are You Prepared for a Major Earthquake?

Everyday Earthquake Preparedness

On July 28, a major earthquake struck Kumamoto. Active faults beneath the city could cause an earthquake with a maximum seismic intensity of 7, making daily preparedness essential. Let's take steps to protect lives by keeping emergency supplies at home, participating in disaster drills, and checking hazard maps.

Store emergency supplies for at least three days, ideally one week

For emergency supplies, we recommend using the “rolling stock” method: buy a little extra of the foods and daily necessities you normally use, such as ready-to-eat packaged foods, canned foods, and water, and use the old items first. This will allow you to have familiar foods even during a disaster.

Prepare for earthquakes at night or early in the morning

Do not place tall furniture, such as dressers or bookshelves, in the bedroom. If you do, be sure to secure it to the wall with L-shaped brackets or other appropriate fittings.

Rearrange furniture so that, even if it tips over, it will not fall onto your bed or *futon* and will not block the doorway.

Keep the following three items in a bag by your pillow or bedside:

- (1) Sturdy slippers (or sneakers): to protect your feet from broken glass and debris
- (2) Flashlight (or headlamp): to light your way during a power outage
- (3) Smartphone or mobile phone: to get information and stay in contact with others

Sheltering at home as an option

When an earthquake strikes, you need to decide whether to evacuate based on the situation. Please check the hazard maps on the city website in advance to understand the risks of landslides and other disasters around your home and workplace.

If your home is safe: Shelter at home if possible.

If your home is at risk of collapse, damage, or fire spreading, or if it is in a landslide warning zone or other area at risk of a secondary disaster: Evacuate promptly.

The following people are excluded: pregnant women; those who had stomach, lung, or intestine surgery within the past one year or are in treatment; those who have barium sensitivity or had aspiration (lung cancer examination is possible); those who had an endoscope stomach cancer check by Nara City in this or the previous fiscal year (lung cancer examination is possible); and those who had a lung cancer low dose CT scan by Nara City in this fiscal year (stomach cancer examination is possible).

Others: For those who are breastfeeding, please notify us of such when you apply. The examination interval is once a year. There might be cases when you may not be able to take the examination depending on your health or questionnaire.

The vaccine requires two or three doses and takes about six months to complete. If you have not yet been vaccinated, please receive your first dose by the end of September.

Men (voluntary vaccination): Up to 15,000 yen per dose (any remaining cost must be paid directly to the medical institution)
