

# Hiroshima Prefectural Industrial Promotion Hall and Atomic Bomb Hypocenter

- Hiroshima -



In an instant, the atomic bomb caused fire to burst up through the ceiling, completely burning the building. However, because the bomb exploded almost directly above here, the main part of the building miraculously withstood the blast.

The remaining walls and the exposed iron frame of the dome remain as a symbol of the atomic bombing as what is now called the Atomic Bomb Dome.
