Kengo Nikawa (then age 59) was on his way to the city to work at a building demolition worksite when he was exposed to the atomic bomb. He suffered severe burns on his right arm to his lower back and on his head. He died on August 22. Kengo always kept this watch on his person as it was a gift from his son.
